Simply put, an introductory phrase is a group of words that comes before the main clause in a sentence. It helps the reader understand more about the main clause. An introductory phrase is not a complete clause; it does not have a subject and a verb of its own. It may have a subject or a verb, but it can't have both.

Introductory it. July 7, 2010 -. When the subject is an infinitive phrase, the sentence often begins with it. Instead of saying 'To find fault with others is easy', we say, 'It is easy to find fault with others'. More examples are given below.

In English, existence is usually indicated by the structure there + to be. There is actually an adverb of place, but the introductory there has no adverbial sense. It is merely used to introduce the sentence. There are two people in the room. (More natural than 'Two people are in the room'.) There is a bridge over the river.

It is unusual to have an infinitive or a that-clause as the subject of a sentence in English. As an alternative we use 'introductory it' as the subject and put the infinitive or that-clause later. That the Americans are friendly is a common belief. It is a common belief that the Americans are friendly.

An introductory phrase is like a clause, but it doesn't have its own subject and verb; it relies on the subject and verb in the main clause. It sets the stage for the main part of the sentence. When you use an introductory phrase in your writing, you're signaling to the reader that the central message of the sentence is yet to come.
