On the evening of 3 May 2007, three-year-old Madeleine McCann disappeared from her family's rented holiday apartment in Praia da Luz, Portugal. Left alone with her two younger siblings whilst her parents and their friends dined nearby, it was assumed that Madeleine had been abducted.
