Requirements for work in the UK UK work visas. UK work-related visas are changing in light of the 2016 Brexit vote. From 1 January 2021, EU/EFTA citizens will be treated the same as third-country nationals and will need a visa to work in the UK. Currently, there are only work visas available in the UK for skilled migrants and those working in shortage occupations. In 2020, the UK government announced the introduction of a new points-based system that will come into effect from the start of 2021.
